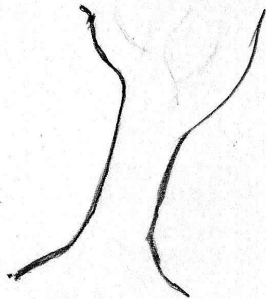


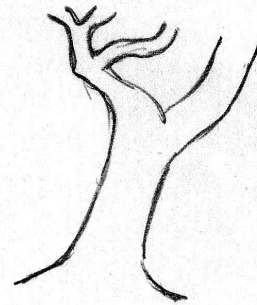
How to DRAW TREES & BACK FOLIAGE

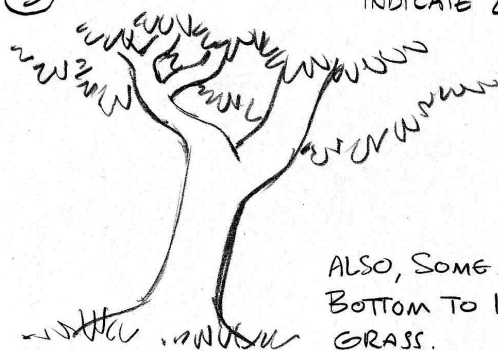
- ① I START TREES WITH THE OUTSIDE EDGES, REMEMBERING THAT TREES ARE FATTER ON TOP & BOTTOM.



- ② THEN, I DIVIDE UP THE TOP PORTION INTO SOME BRANCHES. **DON'T BE SYMMETRICAL.** -TREES DON'T GROW THE SAME ON BOTH SIDES.

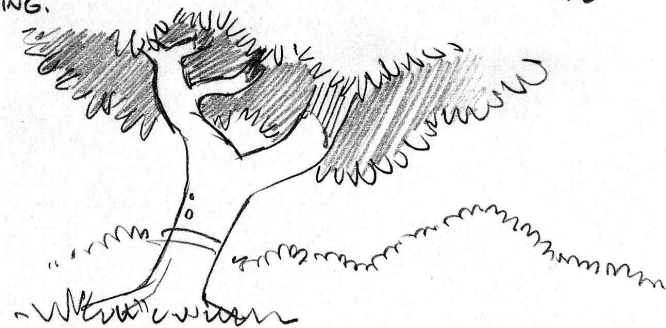


- ③ NEXT, I ADD LOTS OF TINY "U" SHAPES TO INDICATE LEAVES



ALSO, SOME AT THE BOTTOM TO INDICATE GRASS.

- ④ LAST, I ADD SOME INDICATIONS FOR BARK AND SOME SHADING.



YOU CAN ALSO DRAW SOME UPSIDE-DOWN "U"'S IN THE BACK GROUND TO STAND FOR BUSHES IN THE DISTANCE.
