TOP & BOTTOM.


NEXT, I ADD LOTS OF TINY "U" SHAPES TO INDICATE LEAVES

WENT CONTINUE TO THE TOTAL OF THE POST OF

ALSO, SOME AT THE BOTTOM TO INDICATE LINUX GRASS. (2) THEN, I DIVIDE UP THE TOP PORTION INTO SOME BRANCHES, **PON'T** BE SYMETRICAL, -TREES DON'T GROW THE SAME OF

DON'T GROW THE SAME ON BOTH SIDES.

LAST, I ADD SOME INDICATIONS FOR BARK AND SOME



YOU CAN ALSO DRAW SOME UPSIDE. DOWN "U"S IN THE BACK GROUND TO STAND FOR BUSHES IN THE DISTANCE.
